To the staff members from the Attorney General's Office:

The representatives of the Ad Hoc Committee met with you four on November 24, 2015. At that meeting, we raised some critical questions concerning the materials Keiro had submitted to the AG office as the base of its application for selling its facilities to Pacifica. At that same meeting, you revealed to us that there were additional materials which Keiro submitted to you in their effort to further substantiate their application to AG for approval to sell its facilities.

We requested for those additional information and subsequently received them from your office. We analyzed the additional information you provided and sent to you our findings in two separate communications. Additionally, we sent to you a copy of the videoed interview we did with Mr. Frank Omatsu, the only surviving Keiro founder, who categorically refuted the contention of the Keiro management that all founders supported (or had supported while alive) the sale.

At the November 24th meeting, we were told by you that we would be receiving formal response from you on those questions we raised. Nearly a whole month has passed since that day and we are yet to hear from you. In the meantime, the holiday season has come upon us and we are very concerned about the fact that the escrow closure may happen in January. We have sent two letters to you already asking as to when we might receive the promised formal response, and Dr. Keiko Ikeda, a member of the Ad Hoc Committee has even placed a telephone call to you directly, inquiring about the same question.

I urgently request that you would let us know promptly as to when we would be receiving the promised formal response.
