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To the staff members from the Attorney General's Office:

While the Ad Hoc Committee waits for your response to the critical questions we raised on November 24, 2015, we have also investigated the additional material that Ms. Ibanez released to us on December 4, 2015. This information that Keiro had apparently provided to Ms. Ibanez was new to us since it had not been made public until the release date. Please refer to the attachment for detailed findings of our investigation.

We would like to emphasize, however, that even a cursory look at the titles of the meetings indicate that the proposed sale was not part of the agenda. In addition, someone seeking information about the Pacifica transaction would not attend meetings with such titles as: "Vitality Forum: Planning Ahead for You and Your Loves Ones" 2015.02.07 50 attendees or "Vitality Forum: Chronic Kidney Disease" 2015.03.22 160 attendees. These meetings on the supplemental list were verified by the presenter/speaker as presenting no relevance to the proposed Pacifica transaction.

We would again request that your office conduct a thorough investigation of not only the additional material but of all information that Keiro has released to you. The waiver of public hearings based on misleading and irrelevant information that was provided to your office is a serious matter to the citizens of the community.

We thank you in advance for your attention to these matters and for your timely reply.
