For decades, Keiro Senior Healthcare has provided culturally-sensitive, nonprofit health and residency services to Japanese-American elderly in the Los Angeles region. Now, up to 600 low-income seniors may lose their only quality care due to a pending sale of Keiro to a for-profit real estate developer whose corporate goals are not aligned with the community. No public hearing was held, no serious conditions were placed on the sale, and no sufficient support was promised to the hundreds affected.

Please make every effort to attend and support the Ad Hoc Committee to Save Keiro, which formed after the Attorney General approved the sale without a public hearing.
